

1. _____: An important symbol of freedom. It is on Liberty Island in New York Harbor.
Example: This statue welcomes immigrants to America.
2. _____: Are you single, married, widowed, or divorced?
Example: I am not single. I have been married three times. My first marriage ended in divorce. I got married again, but I was widowed when my second wife died. I got married for a third time, and I very happy with my new wife.
3. _____: Money to pay for the government, military, healthcare, schools, etc.
Example: April 15 is the last day to send your Form 1040 to the IRS.
4. _____: A person who has never been married.
Example: I have never been married.
5. _____: The spouse who is still alive after the other spouse dies.
Example: I got married in 2002 and my spouse died in 2010.
6. _____: The system of rules that the people must follow.
Example: I am a Legal Permanent Resident. I follow the rules to live in the United States.
7. _____: To legally end a marriage.
Example: I got married in 2002 and ended the marriage in 2009.
8. _____: To say something true that is supported by facts.
Example: I am a Legal Permanent Resident. I can prove this by showing you my Legal Permanent Resident Card. I promise that everything that I say during my Citizenship interview is true.
9. _____: To lie or say something false that is not supported by facts.
Example: I have never lied and said that I was a US citizen. I cannot prove that I am a US because I only have a Legal Permanent Resident Card and don't have a certificate of naturalization.
